NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES OF YOUR EMPLOYER'S DEFAULT

Notice is hereby given to the employees of

that said employer has defaulted in satisfying the requirements of the Workers Compensation Law.

The employer's account is not in good standing because quarterly reports have not been filed as required and/or premiums and other payments have not been paid as required.

Because of **the employer's default**, injured employees may be entitled to recover damages at common law or by statute by the filing of a lawsuit in addition to obtaining any workers compensation benefits that may be payable.

IMPORTANT: Any person who shall, prior to the reinstatement of the said employer, or prior to sixty days after the posting of said notice, whichever shall first occur, remove, deface or render illegible the said notice, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

DEFACEMENT OR EARLY REMOVAL OF THIS NOTICE IS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE.
